Subject: Red Sinner - Assessment

When I first reached out to the vigilante known as Red Sinner, it was in the hopes of recruiting her and her talents to Project Mycroft. Her willingness to dive into a criminal gathering and defeat them quickly reminded me so much of other vigilantes like Nighthawk.

However, it did not take long for me to realize that this person is driven on a singular mission: finding the fugitive Jackson Blasdel, a.k.a. Jack the Blade; a notorious former member of the Black Aces gang who had since become the most wanted criminal nationwide.

I initially suspected that Red Sinner was either a victim or related to a victim of Blasdel, given her obsessive determination to find him. However, after observing more of her activities, it became obvious that she was a surviving victim of Blasdel. Her connection to the fugitive hunter Ravenclaw, not to mention the continued use of the red gunship dubbed "The Mammoth" that was previously his, has led me to suspect that she was saved from Blasdel's bloody assault in Rhode Island that had earned him his top place in the most wanted category.

In order to secure her services as an investigator, I offered her our information on Blasdel and his operations. Thankfully she did not stray from her mission and her assistance was invaluable. So much so, that when one of my associates had a personal problem with a stalker, I recommended she reach out to Red Sinner for help.

Red Sinner's origin story has now come full circle. The man that "made" her has finally been caught.

When it came to developing the character of Jack the Blade, I came to the realization that this was not someone that I could keep bringing back as a regular villain.

Some villains are so good they can come back again and again. DC's the Joker and Marvel's Loki are such iconic agents of chaos that you can't help but bring them back over and over again. But then you have characters that really just are one-tune figures that have a limited shelf life.

In DC, Joe Chill is one such character. Although he played an important role in the creation of Batman - as the one that made young Bruce Wayne an orphan that fateful night in Crime Alley - he quickly vanished from the scene. There's been little said about Chill other than he may or may not have been caught and he may or may not be behind bars and that he may or may not have died. You don't really see Batman obsessed with hunting Chill down for what happened to him. Instead, he focuses on all criminals, no matter if they are master supervillains like Joker, or just ordinary thugs like Chill.

Jack the Blade is a manipulator and a homicidal psychopath. Even though he is notorious and a wanted felon, he's pretty much a two-dimensional character. He's an agent of chaos because it benefits him. He uses and manipulates people - especially women - because it pleases him. There's nothing redeeming about someone like him. There's really no chance that you could some day see him as changed or reformed, because that would take away the only thing that made him who he is.

Bringing in Nighthawk, the former member of the Champions, was something I wanted to do for a while, to sort of pass the torch from one vigilante to another. He'll always be a part of the city, but now there's someone like him out there still on "this" side of the law.

Jack the Blade created Red Sinner in the same way that Joe Chill created Batman. He will always be remembered for that, although he may not want to take too much of a credit for it. His downfall will serve to bring Red Sinner into being more of an avenging force instead of just an obsessive victim seeking justice.


